Team effort works at Woking

Some outstanding individual performances, along with a fantastic overall team effort helped MADJA to a second place in the Wessex League match at Woking last Sunday.

The event began in the pouring rain, but the determination on the track and in the field was inspiring and the sun emerged for the afternoon!

MADJA U15 Girls and U17 boys were victorious against the five other clubs taking part with the Under 15 boys placed second overall.

Among the outstanding performances of the day were **Max Hughes** (U15 Boys) who ran 4:45.50 to win the 1500m A string; **Edie Noble** who ran 12.9 in the 70m Hurdles — winning by a full second; **Thomas Holmes** who easily won the U15 boys Javelin with a throw of 33.74; **Charlie Curry** (U17) came 1st in both U17 100m and 200m, **Sam Deadman** (U17) who ran a strong race to win the 400m in 56.1secs; **Kieran Short** who won the U17 HJ with a 1.7m and Long Jump with 5.86cm and the 100H in 16.

OUR ATHLETES EXCEL AT SCHOOLS' CHAMPS

MADJA Athletes made their mark at the Wiltshire Schools' Athletics Championships, held at the Salisbury Track last Saturday. There were some excellent Performances and podium places.

Once again, Dan Davis showed epic form to win his 1500m with a time of 4.26.5. Kieran Short came 2nd in his LJ with 5.86cm and followed this with a 2nd in his HJ with a leap of 1.75cm and 3rd in the 100m Hurdles with 15.8secs. Meanwhile, brother Callum won the 400m Hurdles with a time of 56.9secs and came 2nd in the 400m with 51.6secs. In a photo-finish, Charlie Curry was given 2nd in the 100m with a time of 12.1secs that was equal with the 1st place. Thomas Holmes came third in his javelin with 33.68m. Amy Davidson came 3rd in the IG Javelin with 19.05m.

COMPETITION 'ETIQUETTE'

-  Always arrive 15 minutes before your event to register. There will be valuable opportunity for practice/warm up throws/jumps in field events.
-  If your events clash, talk to the official. Register for field events first, but **track events take priority**. Officials can change the order of the competitors. Therefore, ask if you can take at least one jump/throw first before leaving for the track event.
-  Be considerate at the track-side or while waiting to jump/throw so as not to distract other competitors.
-  You are not allowed to take personal music players, wear headphones or take mobile phones inside the track!
-  Please always thank the field event official when you finish.
